Books for you!

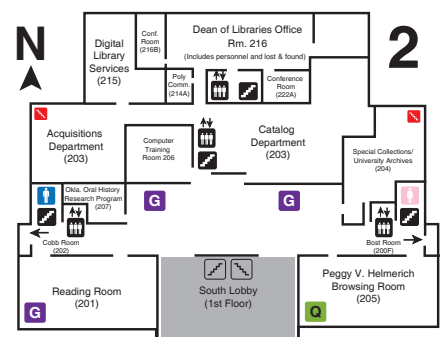
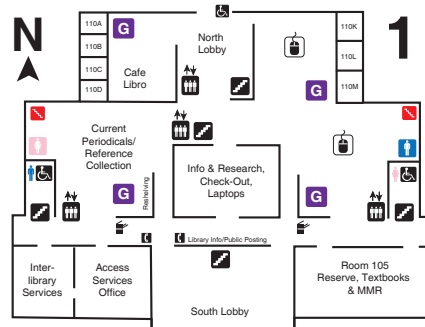
- With your OSU ID, checkout up to 50 books at a time.
- 30-day checkout period
- Books are mainly in the basement, 3rd & 4th floors at the Edmon Low Library.

Reserves, Room 105

- Professors sometimes put print or electronic copies (book chapters, answer sets or homework) "on Reserve."
- Textbooks: The library has textbooks for classes with more than 125 students or costing more than \$125. Checkout time is 2 hours.

- We'll notify you when the book is ready. The recall shortens the due date to 2 weeks.
