The OSU Library will celebrate Oklahoma's statehood with Oklahoma Ovation featuring Jim Barnes on Nov. 20 at 3:30 pm in the Peggy V. Helmerich Browsing Room at the OSU Library.

Barnes is a Native American poet and author who was chosen as Oklahoma's Poet Laureate in 2009. In 1993, he received an Oklahoma Book Award for *The Sawdust War*.

The event is sponsored by the Center for Oklahoma Studies. The event is free and open to the public, and light refreshments will be served.
