UNIVERSITY LIBRARY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The University Library Advisory Committee (ULAC) is a campus-wide committee with representatives from faculty, staff and students. The purpose of ULAC is to advise the Dean of Libraries on issues concerning collections, services, and policy. Members of the committee also act as liaisons with their constituents.

The committee consists of one Faculty Council liaison, as well as seven faculty representatives, one from each college. The President of Faculty Council nominates the faculty representatives. There is one Graduate Faculty Council representative, nominated by the President of the Graduate Faculty Council, and one staff representative, nominated by the President of SAC. Student representatives consist of two graduate students and three undergraduate students nominated by GPSGA and SGA respectively. The current chair of ULAC is Charles Leider, Professor and Director of Landscape Architecture, Horticulture and Landscape Architecture Department.

The Friends of the OSU Library would like to thank the faculty who helped make the opening of the Rudy Miller Art Collection on December 2 a success. The program, which was opened by Dean Sheila Johnson, included remarks from Dr. Jim Shaw of the Zoology Department, Dr. Tony Echelle also from Zoology, and Dr. Mark White of the Art Department. Dr. Miller closed the program by thanking the attendees and taking questions from the audience.

Shaw said, “The Rudy Miller Collection is tangible proof that we still need naturalists today and will continue to need them tomorrow.” Echelle stated, “With his paintings and his book on the fishes of Oklahoma, Rudy is doing more than anyone else to educate the public to the diversity and beauty of fishes in our streams.”
