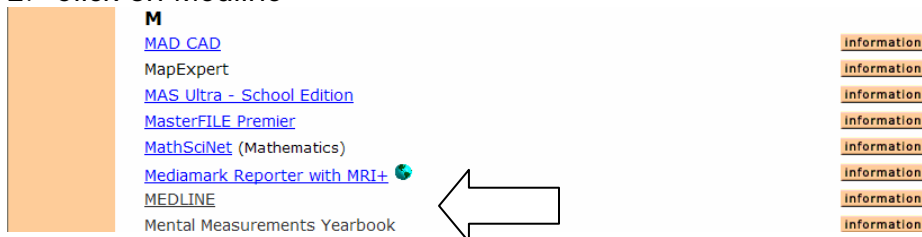


Searching Medline

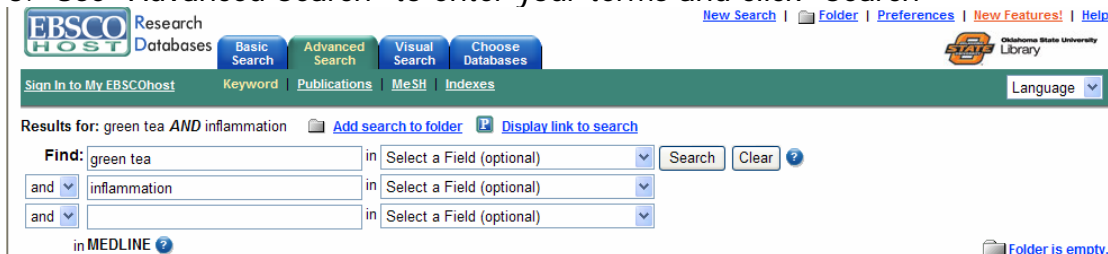
1. Go to Indexes and databases on www.library.okstate.edu
